

Tax Legislation for 2010

[HB 1614](#) Imposes a \$1.50 per barrel fee on petroleum products and dedicates the money to storm water.

[SHB 1738](#) Establishes a program for public financing for the office of Supreme Court Justice.

[HB 2388](#) Imposes the state and local sales tax on candy.

[HB 2390](#) Eliminates the Business and Occupation Tax deduction for initiation fees and dues received by for-profit businesses.

[HB 2417](#) Establishes a public utility tax rate of 50 percent on the gross income of businesses that sell fully unbundled renewable energy credits.

[HB 2473](#) Authorizes a 0.1% sales tax for parks and recreation in Pierce County. (Voter Approved)

[HB 2493](#) Increases the cigarette tax by \$1.00/pack and increases the other tobacco products tax from 75% to 95%.

[HB 2618](#) Allows the cities to impose a new tax for street utility maintenance.

[SB 6616](#)

[SHB 2591](#) Increases fees relating to the processing of water right applications and change applications. Creates a permit exempt well registry with a registration fee. Requires Department of Ecology to adjust the water right application fees on a periodic basis.

[HB 2637](#) Authorizes counties to impose a utility tax and a city tax on water-sewer districts up to 6%.

[HB 2749](#) Authorizes counties to impose a utility tax and a city tax on water-sewer districts up to 6%.

[HB 2797](#) Authorizes counties to impose a 5% tax on mineral extraction.

[HB 2816](#) Imposes a 2.5 cent per gallon fuel tax on exported fuel to other states.

[SHB 2855](#) Authorizes \$20 car tab fee for transit operations without vote of the people for 4 years.

[HB 2965](#) Expands base of oil spill tax from .04 cents to .06 cents per barrel, and indexes the rate each year by the fiscal growth factor.

[HB 2970](#) Addresses loopholes and REET step transactions.

[HB 2971](#) Overturns DOT Foods, Homestreet Bank, and Agrilink court decisions.
[SB 6711](#)

[HB 2972](#) Repeals gold bullion tax exemptions, imposes B&O tax on corporate director fees, limits livestock nutrient management tax exemption.

[HB 3070](#) Imposes a state income tax.
[SB 6250](#)

[HB 3077](#) Repeals the sales tax exemption for coal used at a coal-fired plant
[SB 6573](#)

[HB 3107](#) Eliminates tax incentives for Boeing if they move more than 50% of production out-of-state.

[HB 3120](#) Imposes a .296 cent/ounce tax on wholesale sales of bottled water dedicated to public health.

[HB 3161](#) Imposes a tax on the taxable income of each petroleum business for the privilege of engaging in any business activity within this state.

[HB 3170](#) DNR must impose an annual per parcel assessment of \$4.95 on each taxable
[SSB 6766](#) parcel of land within the state.

[HB 3176](#) Increases state revenue by imposes several new taxes and elimination of tax incentives.

[HB 3179](#) Concerning local excise tax provisions for counties and cities.

[HB 3181](#) Increases the Hazardous Substance Tax rate 0.7 percent to 2.0 percent to
[SB 6851](#) fund water pollution programs and general state programs.

[HB 3183](#) Increase sales tax from 6.5% to 7.5% and adding 1.5% sales tax to all "Motor Vehicle Fuel".

[HB 3184](#) Increasing the estate tax.

[SB 6763](#) Restricts sales and use tax exemptions for machinery and equipment used in the generation of renewable energy.

[SB 6793](#) Raises unemployment benefits and taxes.

[SB 6843](#) Suspends provisions of I-960, allowing all taxes and fees to be passed with a simple majority.

[SB 6847](#) Use and taxation of natural and manufactured gas.

[HB 1608](#) Regulates interior designers and authorizes regulatory fees of \$75
[SB 5514](#) dollars to \$300 dollars.

[HB 1738](#) Adds a \$3 surcharge to all superior and district court filing to provide public funding of court candidates.

[HB 2435](#) Increasing midwife license fee by \$25.

[HB 2488](#) Authorizes counties to charge a \$25 fee to provide a quick title for a vehicle or vessel.

[HB 2508](#) Establishes fees for water right examiner program.

[SHB 2514](#) Creates a crop adjuster category and authorizes fees similar to public adjuster.

[SHB 2569](#) Increases WDFW use permit in steps from \$10 to \$30.
[SB 6690](#)

[HB 2591](#) Increases water right application fees 500% to 1000%.

[HB 2615](#) Increases initiative filing fee from \$5 to \$250.

[SHB 2641](#) Authorizes \$5 mandatory fee on master business license to fund SBDC's.

[SHB 2652](#) Establishes fees for licensing and regulating tanning salons.

[SHB 2688](#) \$200 fee for endorsement of grocery business license to hold beer and wine
[SSB 6329](#) tasting.

[HB 2806](#) Authorizes a \$25 fee for replacement copies of official brand inspection documents.

[HB 2878](#) Establishes fees for electronic processing of lobbying and campaign reports.

[HB 2883](#) Establishes a \$65 fee on sex offenders required to register with county sheriff to enforce registration requirements.

[HB 2906](#) Authorizes an additional \$62 recording fee for assignments or substitutions of existing deeds of trust for housing trust fund projects.

[HB 2914](#) Authorizes fees on producers of mercury containing lights for a recycling and product stewardship program.

[SHB 2954](#) Allows fees for nursing homes and boarding homes to be set in the biennial
[SB 6571](#) appropriations by the legislature.

[HB 2980](#) Increasing field burning fee from \$2.50 to \$3.75, and establishes \$1.00/ton
[SSB 6556](#) pile burning fee.

[HB 3021](#) Establishes nursing home quality maintenance fee.
[SB 6751](#)

[HB 3037](#) Establishes an application submittal fee of \$250, in addition a permit process-
[SSB 6448](#) ing fee from \$275 to \$1,200, and a fee of \$150 for a permit modification.

[SHB 3040](#) Creates a licensing system for appraisal management companies and authorizes fees to administer the program.

[HB 3075](#) Establishes licensing fees for soil and wetland scientists.

[HB 3156](#) Authorizes a \$2,500 annual subscription fee to access online report system for archaeological, historical, cultural, cemetery and human remains information.

[HB 3171](#) Increases the \$30 license tab fee to \$32.43 and allows subagents to deduct
[SB 6404](#) their fees off the higher amount.

[HB 3177](#) Authorizes an additional \$62 recording fee for assignments or substitutions of existing deeds of trust to fund \$100 million of bonds for the Housing Trust Fund.
